DIRECTIONS:

From points North:

Take I-476 South to last toll plaza. Merge onto I-276 and take Exit 333. Follow directions from points East and West.

From points East and West:

Take PA Turnpike I-276 to Exit 333. Take ramp to Norristown, then follow signs onto Plymouth Road. Turn RIGHT onto W. Germantown Pike. Follow directions below from Germantown Road.

From points South:

Take I-476 to Exit 20 to Germantown Pike-West. Turn left at bottom of ramp, onto Plymouth Road. Turn RIGHT onto W. Germantown Pike. Follow directions below from Germantown Road.

On W. Germantown Road, head north/west 0.2 mile. Immediately past Plymouth Meeting Mall turn RIGHT on Hickory Road. Make next LEFT at stop light (Fountain Road). Hotel is on Right.
